

Dignity for All Students Act

*The Dignity Act emphasizes the importance of tolerance and respect for others by students and staff alike. Therefore, all members of the school community, including essential partners such as superintendents, school board members, parents, students, teachers, guidance counselors, principals/administrators, support staff and other school personnel have particularly important roles to play in its implementation. **Students or a parent of a student who feels that they are a target of discrimination or harassment while on school property by any student/students or employee are encouraged to seek out assistance from whomever they feel most comfortable speaking with.** Any staff member who witnesses students being the target of discrimination or harassment or is told of a student being a target of discrimination or harassment must fill out the Little Flower DASA Reporting Form and submit it to the Dignity Act Coordinator. The Dignity Act prohibits discrimination and harassment of students on school property, including at school functions, by any student and/or employee. However, harassment may include, among other things, the use, both on and off school property, of information technology, including, but not limited to, email, instant messaging, blogs, chat rooms, pagers, cell phones, gaming systems and social media websites, to deliberately harass or threaten others. This type of harassment is generally referred to as cyber bullying.

Electronics Protocol

We understand that in this day and age electronics are a very important part of your life. While utilizing your devices, it may result in calming you or helping you relax. We recognize that this is important.

However, these devices can become a distraction or potentially a safety concern in the school environment. So, instead of banning all electronics, we have developed an electronics protocol as follows:

All electronic devices, cell phones & earphones are to be out of sight in the hallway, assemblies and fire/emergency drills

Electronic devices, cell phones & earphones may be used in classrooms **ONLY** with the **permission** of the teacher (part of the lesson, end of class, all work completed & reward for good behavior).

If there is a persistent problem with safety and non-compliance with any of this protocol your device will be confiscated and locked up; and only given back by an administrator or given to a parent or cottage supervisor as part of a conference with the building administrator.
